The day consisted of CLEAT members meticulously recording earthworks on Dial Hill.

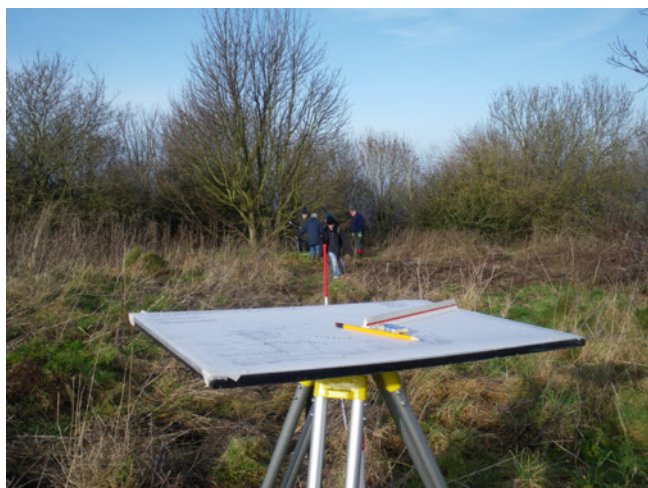
